Class 3 For Herds of 50 breeding cows and over, to include heifers <u>having calved</u> at the time of entry	£ 25.00
Class 4 For Traditional Herds with 6 or more breeding cows. Herd Sire must be designated Traditional and 50% of the cows In the herd must be designated Traditional. The Judges may request to see Registration Certificates to verify eligibility.	£ 25.00

PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUPS presented to the Best Herd in each Classes 1-4

PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP presented to the overall Champion Herd

ROSETTES awarded to the owners of the First, Second, Third and Reserve in each class.

CERTIFICATES OF MERIT given to the Herdsmen of the First, Second, Third and Reserve herds in each class.

SPECIAL PRIZE of £10 awarded for the **Best Stock Bull** in each Class. (Kindly sponsored by Mr. J.A. Covell) (See Conditions of Entry)

SPECIAL AWARD for best **Cow or Heifer with Calf at Foot (both to be judged)** in each Class (Entrants **must** indicate which heifer they wish to be judged on the Entry Form.

PRIZE MONEY

Prize Money of £20, £15 and £10 will be awarded to the Stockperson in charge of the First, Second and Third prize herds respectively in each Class.

POINTS AWARDED

- a) General Breeding Character (Cows)
- b) General Management
- c) In-calf heifers
- d) Yearlings (heifers, steers, bulls)
- e) Stock bull/s

SUSSEX CATTLE SOCIETY HERD COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Competition is open to all registered breeders whose Membership and Capitation Fees for the year have been paid. The number of breeding females entered should closely match the Capitation Fees paid for the year.

A Herd is defined as all animals registered under a single Herd Prefix

All animals in a Herd must be produced for judging and will be judged as a single herd. Calf registrations should be up to date in that Birth Returns should have been sent to the Society Office.

If a breeder manages two herds separately, they may enter both herds but they must be clearly defined as two herds by having separate Herd Prefixes.

Herds engaged in any development programme must have all their breeding females registered with the Sussex Cattle Society inspected, but only those calves sired by either a Registered Sussex Bull or a Bull registered with another Society (whose calves are eligible for registration) will be eligible for inspection and points allocation. All such calves must be Birth Returned with the Society for entry in a supplementary register.

The judging of herds will take place during weeks 17 - 31st July with judging for the Champion Herd to follow shortly afterwards. Note: In some cases there will be leeway due to judges' commitments.

Entries must reach the Secretary by closing date on the attached entry form and accompanied by the Entry Fee – Late entries will not be accepted.

A Class must have a minimum entry of three herds to be judged and prizes to be awarded.

The Society reserves the right to amend classes according to entries based on the number of breeding cows.

The Judges reserve the right to make further inspections of any herds if necessary

Competitors and their exhibits shall be subject to the general rules of the Sussex Cattle Society and the interpretation of these conditions. The Council reserves the right to refuse any entry or to withhold any Prize without giving a reason

The Judge's decision is final.

Competitors must arrange to show their herds upon the day selected and make them as accessible as possible, as the Judges' time is limited. A knowledgeable person must be available to guide the judges during their visit or the herd will be unplaced.

Protests must be made in writing within three days of the results being published, accompanied by a deposit of £50.00. If the protest is found to be unfounded the deposit will be forfeited and placed in the Society's funds.

In cases where no stock bull is kept the bull seen will be judged, if the bull is not available the judges will allocate marks at their discretion based on the calves seen. If there are no in calf heifers or yearlings, the judges will allocate marks accordingly for that section.

Best Stock Bull in Class

The bull or bulls entered must be owned by the entrant in that Class and viewed on the day. The bull may be the current sire in use and/or the sire of the current crop of calves.
